Sculptures at COP29

Artist Jens Galschiøts (DK) sculptures have gained prominent visibility at several previous climate conferences, including COP conferences.

For COP29 in Baku, the artist has made 3 sculptures which will undoubtedly attract attention. The focus is inequality and resource redistribution to allow poorer countries to cope with climate change.

Exhibition sites and duration:

Examples: Pavilions, side events and debate. The artist is present for presentation of the sculpture and for artist talk.

By the sculptures, materials and 3D-printed mini-sculptures will be distributed, allowing participants to take home an artistic reminder.

Installation (no) expenses:

- The only thing needed is permission to install the sculpture.
- The sculptures are fully funded, insured and very stable.
- Installation: Done by hand by the artists staff.
- Size of the sculptures: 150cm + base. Base is 50cm x 50cm
- Weight: Around 50kg in total.
