

Sculpture Installation at COP29 in Baku

For COP29 in Baku, the artist has made 3 sculptures which will undoubtedly attract attention. The focus is resource redistribution to allow poorer countries to cope with climate change.

Exhibition sites and duration:

Pavilions, side events and debates.

By the sculptures, materials and 3D-printed mini-sculptures will be distributed, allowing participants to take home an artistic reminder.

Installation (no) expenses:

- The only thing needed is permission to install the sculpture.
- The sculptures are fully funded, insured and very stable.
- Installation: Done by hand by the artists staff.
- Size of the sculptures: 150cm + base.
- Weight: Around 50kg in total.
